

US Bioservices now dispenses LENVIMA[®] (lenvatinib)

LENVIMA[®] (lenvatinib) is a kinase inhibitor indicated for the treatment of patients with locally recurrent or metastatic, progressive, radioactive iodine-refractory differentiated thyroid cancer (DTC) and in combination with everolimus to treat patients with advanced renal cell carcinoma (RCC) following one prior antiangiogenic therapy. LENVIMA is indicated for the first-line treatment of patients with unresectable hepatocellular carcinoma (HCC). It is also indicated in combination with pembrolizumab for the treatment of patients with advanced endometrial carcinoma that is not microsatellite instability-high (MSI-H) or mismatch repair deficient (dMMR), who have disease progression following prior systemic therapy and are not candidates for curative surgery or radiation.

Options for sending prescriptions to US Bioservices

1. Portal

Send online prescription orders through the MyPathpoint Prescriber Portal. To login or register visit mypathpoint.com

2. E-Prescribe

Search for US Bioservices under 'Retail Pharmacy,' select 'Texas' as the state, and send the prescription. Include the ICD-10 code and patient insurance information in the pharmacy notes section or fax it to (888) 899-0067. If you wish to have US Bioservices act on your behalf to initiate the prior authorization process, insert the following attestation language exactly as it appears below in the comments section of your e-prescription.

"I authorize US Bioservices to act on behalf of myself and my patient to initiate any de minimis authorization process from health plans including the submission of any necessary forms to such health plans."

3. Fax
